

## **Chemical Peel**

## **Post-Procedure Instructions**

- 1. After treatment, your skin may feel sensitive, tight, dry, and may appear pink, red or slightly swollen.
- 2. Discomfort is rare, but if it occurs it may be reduced using Tylenol (acetaminophen) and you may also use cold compresses.
- 3. You skin may peel to varying degrees (mild, moderate, severe) depending on the treatment received and the condition of the skin prior to treatment. Peeling may last up to 2 weeks.
- 4. Apply post procedure topical products such as Avene post procedure, Aquaphor, or Vaseline as instructed. Moisturizers may be used several times a day to hydrate the skin. Apply an SPF 30 or higher daily and avoid direct sun exposure.
- 5. Avoid strenuous exercise, hot tubs, steam rooms, saunas, or excessively hot showers for the first few days after treatment.
- 6. Avoid picking, scrubbing, or exfoliating the skin. This may result in irritation, scarring, and skin pigmentation changes.
- 7. Avoid facial waxes, electrolysis, and the use of depilatories for 2 weeks after treatment.
- 8. You may resume alpha hydroxyl and retinoic acids 1-2 weeks after treatment or as instructed.
