

<u>Cryosurgery (Liquid Nitrogen) Post Procedure</u> <u>Instructions</u>

- Areas treated with liquid nitrogen will be red for a few days following treatment and may swell or blister. The treated areas will then scab or become crusted before falling off.
- 2. Wash the area gently with mild soap and water. To ensure proper healing, **DO NOT** scrub or pick at the treated sites.
- 3. Use a healing cream or ointment such as Avene Cicalfate, Aquaphor, or Vaseline <u>twice</u> <u>daily</u>. We **DO NOT** recommend Neosporin due to the risk of allergic reaction.
- 4. Protect the area(s) treated from sun exposure to prevent the area from darkening and apply a sunscreen of at least SPF 45 on the area daily for 4 weeks.
- 5. For wart treatment, if prescribed, apply Aldara or imiquimod cream to warts 5 times a week or as directed. Warts can be covered with a bandage after applying the cream.
