



Biopsy Post Procedure Instructions

1. The bandage that was applied to the wound today may be left on overnight. Remove the bandage the following day and clean the wound with mild soap and water.
2. Use a healing ointment or cream such as Avene Cicalfate, Vaseline, or Aquaphor twice daily. We **DO NOT** recommend using Neosporin due to the risk of allergic reaction.
3. If the wound starts to bleed, apply pressure for 15-20 minutes and elevate the area if it is located on a limb (for example, the arm or leg).
4. Avoid sun exposure to the area.
5. Contact the office at 724-935-9133 if any signs of infection develop such as:
 - Redness
 - Warmth
 - Drainage from the wound
6. Suture removal, if applicable, will be scheduled in 7-14 days.

Biopsy Results

1. Biopsy results will be available in **10 business days** from the date of your procedure. **Results are available Monday through Thursday between the hours of 2pm and 4pm.**
2. We will contact you if your biopsy results are **abnormal**.
3. We **DO NOT** contact patients for **benign** or **normal** results. If you do not hear from us, that means the results were normal and there is no need for a follow up visit.
